

Peach Announces Traffic Result for FY 2016 Bon Vacation Period

Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) has today released its performance for the Japanese Bon vacation period (August 10-21) FY 2016.

3) Topics

Many customers flew Peach on both its domestic and international routes. Performance was steady with overall volume supplied over the Bon vacation period at 113% compared to a year earlier, and the number of passengers at 114% YOY.

As to performance by route, there were no significant variances and many customers flew Peach on all of its routes.

August 11, a new holiday added to the Japanese calendar this year, was the peak day for outbound routes on both domestic and international routes, and August 15 and August 19 were peak days for inbound routes for domestic and international routes respectively.

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport as a secondary hub in July 2014 and began servicing Haneda Airport in August 2015. More than 13,000 passengers currently board Peach each day as it offers services on 24 routes: 14 domestic and 10 international. Peach is planning to set up a hub at Sendai Airport in 2017.
