Peach Aviation Limited (hereinafter referred to as Peach, Representative Director and CEO: Kazunari Ohashi) shall commence sales of tickets for select routes for the 2025 summer schedule (March 30 to October 25, 2025) beginning at 4:00 PM today.(November 7,2024)

This sale applies to 14 domestic routes, including Sapporo (New Chitose), Sendai, and Nagoya (Chubu), as well as 11 international routes, including Seoul (Incheon), Taipei (Taoyuan), and Hong Kong.

Peach has also revised its fare types, effective for flights departing on or after October 27. The "Standard" type, which includes seat selection and checked baggage fees and has no ticket issuance fees, has been particularly popular.

Peach flights will be more convenient than ever, making travel even more enjoyable. We hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to travel during the upcoming spring through fall months.
