First for a Japanese Airline! Nagoya (Chubu) – Seoul (Gimpo) Route Inauguration! - A versatile trip to Seoul for sightseeing and business -

- Peach will be the only airline that services to Nagoya (Chubu) to operate the route between Nagoya (Chubu) and Seoul (Gimpo).
- Starting Thursday, April 10, 7 flights per week (one round trip per day) will be serviced.
- Increasing the number of flights to 14 per week (two round trips per day) from Tuesday,
 August 26
- Fares start at JPY 5,780 one-way, and tickets go on sale today at 1:00 p.m.
- Nagoya (Chubu) routes will be expanded to a total of five routes: three domestic routes and two international routes

Osaka, February 20, 2025 - Peach Aviation Limited (hereinafter referred to as Peach, Representative Director & CEO: Kazunari Ohashi) has announced that it will launch the Nagoya (Chubu) - Seoul (Gimpo) route starting from Thursday, April 10. Sales of the tickets will begin from 1:00pm today. Fares start at JPY 5,780 with no fuel surcharge.

The Nagoya (Chubu) - Seoul (Gimpo) route is the second international route from Nagoya, following the Nagoya (Chubu) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route that inaugurated on March 27, 2023. Peach is the only airline serving Chubu Airport that operates daily flights to Seoul Gimpo International Airport, seven times a week.



Seoul Gimpo International Airport is a very convenient airport with access to downtown Seoul city in about 25 minutes by train. With minimal travel time from the airport, customers can enjoy local attractions such as sightseeing, shopping, and visiting cafes to the fullest, and it is also very convenient for business travelers. In addition, starting Tuesday, August 26, the number of flights will be increased to 14 per week (two round trips per day), giving customers more options for their schedules. Please enjoy a more accessible trip to Seoul, tailored to your needs.

The South Korea route was Peach's first international flight from Osaka (Kansai) to Seoul (Incheon) which inaugurated service in May 2012. Currently, the number of flights serviced to Seoul per day is the highest* among Japanese airlines. Since inaugurating service in 2012, the cumulative number of passengers on the Korea route has reached approximately 5.8 million by the end of last year, making it one of Peach's most popular international routes with many customers using it. Additionally, this year marks the 60th anniversary of the normalization of diplomatic relations between Japan and South Korea, and this new route will be the second international route from

Nagoya, which also marks the 5th anniversary of the inauguration of Peach's Nagoya (Chubu) route. With the opening of the new Nagoya (Chubu) route, there will be a total of five routes: three domestic routes and two international routes, further expanding the number of travel options. Peach will continue to serve as a bridge between Asia, boosting the traffic between Japan and South Korea, contributing to the revitalization of relations between the two countries.

The Nagoya (Chubu) - Seoul (Gimpo) route will increase the number of flights to 14 per week (two round trips per day) from Tuesday, August 26.

Peach's top priority is to operate safely. As a bridge between Japan and South Korea, which will become more active in the future from the three major cities of Tokyo, Nagoya, and Osaka, we will offer a variety of travel options to further promote exchanges between the two countries.
