### **2025 Summer Schedule Ticket Sales Open for All Routes**

**Osaka, January 23, 2025** - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Kazunari Ohashi) announced today, we have begun additional ticket sales for flights during the Summer 2025 schedule (March 30 to October 25, 2025). Including previously announced routes, tickets for all 25 domestic and 13 international routes are now available. \*1

The routes and fares for tickets that will go on sale today are shown in the table below. Tickets can be purchased via the Peach Website ([www.flypeach.com](http://www.flypeach.com)) and at the Contact Center.



During the Summer Schedule, domestic flights will see increased demand-based adjustments, such as expanding the Nagoya (Chubu) – Okinawa (Naha) route to a maximum of two round trips per day. Period operations will also include Osaka (Kansai) – Kushiro \*2 and Memanbetsu \*3 routes. On the international front, 13 routes will continue to operate from 5 domestic airports (Haneda, Narita, Chubu, Kansai, and Naha), catering to inbound demand. Additionally, we are exploring the introduction of new routes to Asia. In FY2024, the cumulative number of domestic passengers on Kansai routes exceeded 40 million, while international passengers surpassed 10 million, reflecting continued strong support from our customers.

Peach will continue to prioritize safe operation, transcend the barrier of distance, and enrich people's lives as a public transportation service that allows everyone to easily experience new scenery. We will continue to innovate and work hard to deliver “A flight full of respect for everyone.”
