Peach Announces 2013 Summer Flight Timetable Flights Open for Sendai, New Ishigaki, Busan

- · Osaka (Kansai) Sendai Route: Starts April 12
- · Osaka (Kansai) New Ishigaki Route: Starts June 14
- · Okinawa (Naga) New Ishigaki Route: Starts Sept 13
- Osaka (Kansai) Busan, South Korea Route: Starts Sept (tentative)
- Sales for Seats for Domestic Routes Start Today at 5 pm
- Campaign Starts on 5 Existing Domestic Routes from Jan 23

Peach Aviation Limited (Peach; CEO: Shinichi Inoue; headquartered in Izumisano, Osaka), Japan's first dedicated low cost carrier, announced today the flight plans for its 2013 Domestic Flight Summer Timetable (Mar 31 – Oct 26) and has applied to the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism for approval.

For its domestic routes, Peach will open a new Osaka (Kansai) – Sendai route on April 12; an Osaka (Kansai) – New Ishigaki route on June 14; and also an Okinawa (Naha) – New Ishigaki route on September 13. As to international routes, it plans to open an Osaka (Kansai) – Busan, South Korea route starting in September.

With these new additions, the routes operated by Peach in the Summer Timetable will become 8 domestic routes and 4 international routes. At the press conference held today at Ishigaki, Peach's CEO Shinichi Inoue commented "this expansion represents a major comittment to developing and growing tourist destination with superb beach, but we will bring even more tourists here. Peach will also grow tourism and passengers between Kansai and Sendai, our first destination in Tohoku, and Busan. Peach will expand to offer safe, reliable and affordable air travel 365 days a year."

Peach plans to expand its current lineup of six aircraft to ten aircraft by the summer of 2013, and intends to boost its lineup to 17 aircraft in the latter half of 2015.

In addition, starting today, Peach has increased the number of flights between Osaka (Kansai) and Okinawa (Naha) by 1 roundtrip flight per day, and is now operating 3 roundtrip flights (6 flights) each day. With the increased number of flights in the morning, for which many requests have been received, the convenience of travel between Kansai and Okinawa will be further enhanced.
